UNIFORM RENTAL POLICY:

- Cheerleaders will receive the following items as part of their rental uniform:
 - Skirt
 - Vest
 - Mock Turtleneck
- Football Players will receive the following items as part of their rental uniform (players keep game jersey):
 - Helmet / Chin Strap
 - Shoulder Pads
 - Practice Jersey & Pant
 - Game Pants
 - Pads for pant
- Parents are responsible for obtaining and returning equipment. Once you receive equipment, you cannot borrow equipment that you left at home.
- Cheerleaders and football players may also receive other items as part of their player registration costs that they may keep at the end of the season. Only the above items must be returned.
- You may also be required to purchase other items not included in the program registration costs. These items will be discussed with you during registration.
- Failure to return the uniform at the end of the season will result in the following charges to the parent.
Football: \$250.00
Cheer: \$125.00
Until the uniform is returned or the charges are paid, your child will be unable to participate in any other sports programs offered by the Oak Ridge Youth Association. We are also unable to release you to participate in any other Pop Warner program.

PARENT VOLUNTEER EXPECTATIONS:

- We have many opportunities for parents to volunteer and participate in our organization. Your help is always appreciated. During football season, we request a minimum level of volunteer participation from each participant.
- All parents **must** work one game and one practice in concession during the season. This is required for each child that you have participating in the program. After game grounds cleanup or practice field cleanup will be assigned as required. You may also be asked by your coach to assist in bringing snacks and drinks/water for your team after games. In each case, the Team Parent will be responsible for scheduling times.

PARENT'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

- In order to uphold the goal of Pop Warner and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment. All parents and guardians and other adults and attendees of Pop Warner events including but not limited to practices, competitions, and banquets, must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times.
- Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or non-prescription drugs and /or appears intoxicated at a Pop Warner event and/ or who is flagrantly ruse, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuse, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language / gestures with an official. Coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, must receive a verbal warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior The adult's children may also be removed from the event. Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for a period of one year from the date of the second offense, and their children may be removed from the program(s) for that period of time.
- Any adult who physically assaults an official, coach, volunteer, staff member or participant or threatens grave bodily harm may be banned from any and all Pop Warner events for one year from the date of the offense, and their children may also be removed from any and all Pop Warner programs for that same period of time. After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense of the adult code of conduct, the individual will be permanently banned from any and all Pop Warner events and the individual's children may also be permanently removed from any and all Pop Warner programs.

Parent and child agree to follow and abide by the rules and regulations of "Pop Warner" National Football, Northwest Midget Football League and the Oak Ridge Youth Association.
