- REGISTRATION** Runs through January 31st. Late fee assessed as of Feb 1.

- COST** Spring 2012 - \$100 Fall players returning pay \$35.
Includes – Jersey, Shorts & Socks
You provide - shin guards, cleats and soccer ball
(Size 3 - ages 4-7; Size 4 - ages 8-11; Size 5 - ages 12-17)
- PRACTICE** Circle 3 available practice nights as we try to roster your child on a night available to you. We attempt to place all players with Oak Ridge teams practicing in Oak Ridge. Coaches receive roster updates **Early February**. Practices begin **mid-February**.
- FALL SEASON** – Begins **March**. Games will be played at the Parks Chevrolet Soccer Complex @ Beeson Road Park in Kernersville and Oak Ridge Town Park on weekends.
- REMEMBER . . .** ORYA is always looking for **VOLUNTEERS** - businesses to sponsor teams, Volunteers to help with registration and tournaments, or serve as Coaches, Assistant Coaches, or on our Board of Directors. It can be a rewarding experience!
- Notify ORYA **ASAP** if there are any changes, especially addresses and phone numbers. Children are placed on teams based on info provided. **Any rostering** due to misinformation or changes will be **assessed a \$40 Rostering Fee**.
- Siblings** can play on same team only if they fall within the same age group or complete a tryout to play up with the Oak Ridge Soccer Director. NCYSA does not allow for a child to play down an age level.
- Waiver** must be signed before child can practice or play. Copy of Birth Certificate is required to register.
- NCYSA prohibits the wearing of jewelry during games.** This includes any loose jewelry; i.e., chains, watches, earrings (**NO EXCEPTIONS**), metal hair clips. Casts may be allowed at the referee's discretion if they are properly wrapped and not deemed dangerous to the player and/or other players.

1. What if my child has never played soccer before? This is a recreational soccer league that is open to all levels of players. Games are competitive and geared toward having fun.
2. Why is registration so early? Teams are created and practices start in February. Uniforms need to be ordered.
3. What if I want my child to play on the same team as his/her friend? What if I want my child to have/not have a certain coach? KSA and ORYA cannot guarantee special requests for rostering. Every intention is made to have teams be as evenly competitive as possible and honoring all special requests makes that very difficult.
4. How much do Soccer coaches, directors and others involved get paid from the fees paid per player? Nothing. The coaches, the soccer director, the volunteers that line fields, mow lawns, move and assemble goals and everything to cleaning bathrooms are ALL volunteer positions within ORYA. No special benefits or discounts are afforded their children.
5. Can my daughter play COED. Yes. Under 6 is COED only. Under 8 and above is Girls or COED. Very few females play COED at the recreational level before Under 15 but it is an option if you so choose.
6. How do I choose what size clothing my child should order? There are samples at the KSA office at Beeson park. Most find uniforms to run a bit small and remember your child is growing. If they will play Fall and Spring, they will wear the same uniform all year. Please plan accordingly.
7. Why is there a late fee? Volunteers put in countless hours to put rosters together and order uniforms, by registering late, this makes the task all the more difficult as often, changes have to be made.

Code of Conduct

1. I WILL RESPECT THE AUTHORITY OF MY CHILD'S ASSIGNED COACH. I understand that this is a recreation league where all players participate. I also understand that soccer is a competitive game and coaches are trying to win games. Coaches are required to play each player one half of each game; any time beyond that is at the discretion of the coach. I understand that coaches have the right to play players at any position for any amount of time.
2. I WILL RESPECT THE OPPOSING PLAYERS, COACHES & SPECTATORS. I will not communicate any critical, abusive, offensive or disrespectful comment about or toward any person associated with the opposing team.
3. I WILL RESPECT THE AUTHORITY OF THE REFEREES.
I understand that soccer is officiated by referees and their assistants, not coaches, players, parents or spectators. I will voice any concerns I have about the officiating to my child's coach after the game. If the coach feels it is necessary, he will discuss the matter with the KSA referee assignor or the VP of Rec after the game.
4. I WILL NOT SIT OR STAND BEHIND THE GOAL OR PENALTY AREA. The "clear zone" behind each goal line is not to be used by spectators.
5. IF I AM ASKED TO LEAVE THE FIELD I WILL DO SO IMMEDIATELY. I understand that the coach, referee or any KSA official may ask me to leave the complex if I have violated any of The Code of Conduct. I may be suspended from attending soccer games or visiting the fields. The suspension may be any duration, from 1 game to a lifetime suspension, depending on the severity of the violation. A member of the KSA Board will tell me how long my suspension is to be and I will abide by its decision.

Soccer is a game. Youth soccer is supposed to be fun for ALL participants. We are trying to promote good sportsmanship, teamwork and build self-confidence. Your good example is crucial in enabling us to meet this goal.
